Dear Companions,

Happy New Year from the JCoLT team. We hope you had a joyful Christmas and were able to celebrate with family and friends. The team met in Sydney in January and had a productive 3 day gathering. We met with the Sisters on the Congregational Leadership Team as well as Luke Stevens the General Manager.

We have been working closely with the sisters and Luke over the past two years to establish the best way forward for the movement. This has been an interesting journey with many bumps along the way. We do however believe we have established the correct structure to assist the movement to move forward as a sustainable vibrant pathway to living the Josephite Charism.

There will be changes, but many of these changes are centred around finance and governance and will not make a huge difference to local groups. They will however strengthen our position and ensure we are a sustainable and responsible organisation. The first major change will be the introduction of a central account with all monies being collected going to this account; ensuring we are transparent and functioning under the guidelines of the Trustees of the Sisters of Saint Joseph. This account will then be accessed through a working account which each region will have access to via debit cards. The regions are working with JCoLT to establish financial policies around access and expenditure. Local groups will continue to operate as they do now.

We are all very aware that we live in a different world today and the need to be financially sustainable is a reality for our movement. We can no longer rely on the sisters to 'prop' up our finances. Many regions already have a subscription in place and other regions operate under donations, we have reached a point where we need to bring all regions under the same policy. To this end we will be implementing a yearly subscription of \$30. While this is not a huge amount, we acknowledge that this may be difficult for some, the Companions will never be a movement that excludes someone who cannot pay the subscription. We do ask however that you contribute what you can afford.
